If this is your first time attending, you will find the monthly Yorkville Art Walk is an ideal opportunity to view and consider a wide range of quality originals from exceptional artists. Guests will see a broad range of styles and media with something for everyone. The exhibiting artist for Scolllard Street Gallery, Ritchie Sinclair, will be in attendance for the October walk. Ingram Gallery will not be participating this month but have donated a pair of tickets to the Toronto International Art Fair. The tickets will be awarded to a lucky Art Walk attendee by way of a draw to be conducted at the Coffee Mill at the conclusion of the walk.

NOTE: Eight galleries will be participating this month. Four galleries will be continuting the exhibitions that were in place for last month's walk.
