If this is your first time attending, you will find the monthly Yorkville Art Walk is an ideal opportunity to view and consider a wide range of quality originals from exceptional artists. Guests will see a broad range of styles and media with something for everyone. The exhibiting artist for Scollard Street Gallery, **Ritchie Sinclair**, will be in attendance for the October walk. **Ingram Gallery will not be participating this month but have donated a pair of tickets to the Toronto International Art Fair.** The tickets will be awarded to a lucky Art Walk attendee by way of a draw to be conducted at the Coffee Mill at the conclusion of the walk.

NOTE: Eight galleries will be participating this month. Four galleries will be continuing the exhibitions that were in place for last month's walk.
